<u>Attendance</u>

This week we have had had very good attendance in school with 96.2% with Year 3 winning Attendance Ted with superb attendance of 98.77%. Here is a reminder of our day to day procedures.

Our day to day procedures for parents

Thank you to everyone who makes sure that their child comes to school every day that they can and helps them to get to school on time. It really helps children to have a good, calm start to the day and not miss out on any learning.

• Children should be on the playground by about 8:50am.

• The classroom doors will be open from 8:55am for children in Reception and KS1. For KS2 children the doors will open at 9am, teachers will come out and children should line up outside their classrooms. A whistle will be blown if children are playing on the pitch.

• The afternoon register will be taken at 1.00pm for KS2 and 1.10pm for KS1 – the school day ends at 3.30pm for Years 1-6 and 3:25pm for Reception.

Children who are too late to come into school with their class should come in via the office and parents should sign in on the school inventory. Children in Years 5 and 6 can sign in by themselves.
If your child will not be in school, please ring us as soon as possible before 9am to tell us why or leave a message on the answer phone or leave a message on Parentmail.

• If they are off a second or further day, please ring each day of their absence unless the first phone call gave a clear reason for more than one day off (e.g. a doctor has specified an amount of time off school).

• If we have not heard from you, we will ring you and if we are unable to make contact, conduct a home visit. This is to safeguard the children in case a child is not in school without you knowing.

• If your child needs to miss school for a medical appointment, please show us proof of the appointment (this can be an appointment card, prescription, text reminder or note from the receptionist). This applies at any point in the school day, including early pick-ups.

We monitor attendance and punctuality daily to ensure that children are getting the education they need. If we notice that a pattern is emerging, or a child is in danger of being classed as 'persistently absent' (attendance below 90%) we will write to you to make sure you are aware. We are help to help and provide support to make good attendance and punctuality easier.

<u>Clubs</u>

Just a reminder that Cricket Club has now finished until next year. Our football clubs will take place next week but will then finish until next week due to the lack of light after school. We still have lots of places in our Samba Band club which takes place on Wednesdays after school. If your child is interested in joining the Samba Band Club, please can you let either your child's teacher or myself know.

Year 1 Hearing Check

The nurses will be in school next Thursday 16th November to carry out the hearing check with Year 1. All Year 1 parents will have received information about the check through Parentmail.
